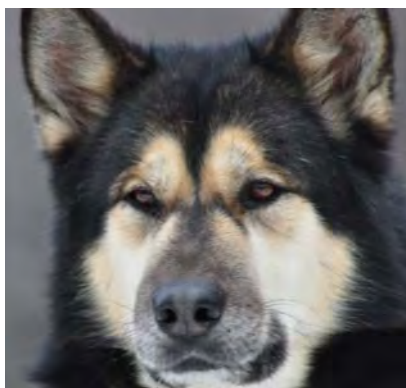
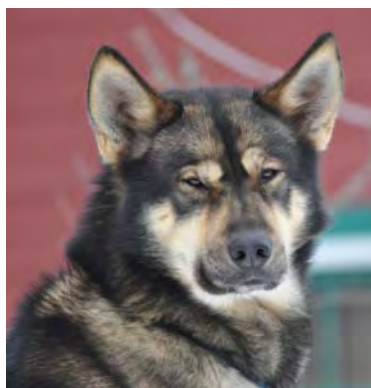


## Doggie News

Dougette and Diedre's puppies are now in harness and doing really well on short runs. They are so much fun to train!

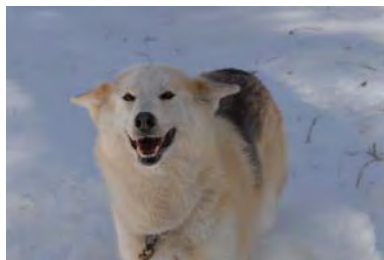

## Farewell to Some Dear Canine Friends

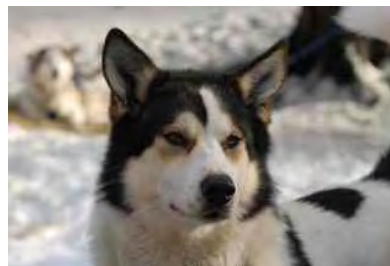
Since our last newsletter, we said good-bye to Nelly, Banshee, and Finn. They will be missed!
